The Committee on Jewish Law and Standards (CJLS) is sponsoring the International Seminar for Halakhic Study, a movement-wide seminar in which Conservative/Masorti congregations, communities, and schools will come together to study a specific teshuvah of the CJLS. During the Jewish year of 5782 (2021-2022), the teshuvah is Adoption by Rabbi Nate Crane. Each community around the world will feature its own teacher. BHBE will join together with Rabbi Crane.
