**Commemoration: Kristallnacht 84 Years Later: The Suitcase, hosted by the Illinois Holocaust Museum, November 9, 6pm.** Join us as we commemorate the 84th anniversary of the "Night of Broken Glass" with a program of remembrance, reflection, and performance. This powerful intergenerational commemoration will feature *The Suitcase*, a one-man show by **Tim Lorsch**, the first-born son of Jews who fled Nazi Germany in the late 1930s. The performance will be preceded by remarks from dignitaries, a candle-lighting ceremony featuring Survivors and descendants of Survivors, as well as memorial prayers with **Cantor Roytman**.
