Rabbi Pamela Barmash, Ph.D., is Professor of Hebrew Bible and Biblical Hebrew at Washington University in St. Louis and has served as director of Jewish, Islamic and Near Eastern Studies there. Before that, she served as the rabbi at Temple Shaare Tefilah, Norwood, Massachusetts. She is the chair of the Committee on Jewish Law and Standards of the Rabbinical Assembly and is also a dayyan on the (International) Joint Beit Din of the Conservative/Masorti Movement. She earned a B.A. from Yale University, rabbinic ordination from the Jewish Theological Seminary, and Ph.D. from Harvard University. She was the 17th woman ordained as a Conservative rabbi.
